Trails are through jack pine and aspen forest with a mile or so of sandy road. There will be a river crossing on each trail. Footing is sandy, or grassy with only a short stretch of rocky ground, and 1 mile of gravel road on the long loop.

Directions

From High Prairie, AB, Take Hwy 749 north (MAC's intersection). Drive until you cross the South Heart River Bridge, slow down, and take your next left (west on TWP 755B). Follow this gravel road approximately 2 miles and you will see signs leading you to camp.

Camping

Camp open Friday at Noon. We will be in a flat field. Water for horses will be available around camp and in crewing area. Field is alfalfa. No power so bring your generator. Porta-potties on site. Manure to be spread when we leave and all garbage taken away with you. Dogs are welcome but cannot be off leash and are not allowed in vetting and crewing areas at any time.

No Frills Ride

Meals will be provided for our volunteers and vets. Light snacks (fruit, cookies, bars) will be provided for riders, but there will be no dinner on Saturday or Sunday after the rides. We do hope to have a bonfire Saturday night.
