FROM SOUTH (WESTLOCK): Head North through Westlock on Highway 44 for 23 kms to the Hwy 881/601 Junction (Dapp Corner Store). Turn right onto Hwy 801. Go north 12 kms until you see the sign for Long Island Lake (Twp Rd 633A). Turn Right onto Township Road 633A (winds and turns into Twp Rd 634A) and proceed east 4.6 kms until you hit the fork in the road. Take the left fork and proceed to ride camp on the Right side of the road – Long Island Lake Horse Club grounds.

FROM NORTH (SLAVE LAKE): Head South towards Westlock on Highway 44 to Hwy 881/601 Junction (Dapp Corner Store). Turn left onto Hwy 801. Go North 12 kms until you see the sign for Long Island Lake (Twp Rd 633A). Turn Right onto Township Road 633A (winds and turns into Twp Rd 634A) and proceed east 4.6 kms until you hit the fork in the road. Take the left fork and proceed to ride camp on the right side of the road – Long Island Lake Horse Association grounds.

Ride Details: The trails are a combination of anything the bush can throw at you. It is a natural wild environment ranging from sandy trails, some muddy spots, dense bush, and lots of steep hills. These trails are frequented by ATV/ dirt bikes so be prepared to handle this. There will be some road near camp, along with lease road. There will be some road sections on both the 25 mile and 50 miles rides and hoof protection is recommended.

Ride Meetings are at 8:00 PM in the hall on Friday and Saturday

Vet in will begin around 5:00 PM on Friday

Food will only be provided for Volunteers, however, **there will be a potluck on Saturday evening.**

Camping: Long Island Lake Light horse club. Ride camp opens at Noon on Friday August 11, though early and late departure is acceptable, however, please advise Natasha. There is minimal grass so ensure to bring alternate feed. Fresh water for horses will be provided. Porta-poties will be on site. There is limited parking so we ask that riders be mindful of space when setting up pens. At this time there is no location for manure disposal so be prepared to take it out with you if other arrangements cannot be made with the landowner. All dogs are to be on leash AT ALL TIMES. No dogs allowed in the hall or the arena. No fires allowed on site.
