Ride Details

Trails are through jack pine and aspen forest with a mile or so of sandy road. There will be a river crossing on each trail. Footing is sandy or soil with only a short stretch of rocky ground.

Ride Meetings 8:00pm Friday and Saturday in camp. Vetting to start Friday at 4:00pm

Intro riders have the choice of the 10 or 15 mile loop. NOTE: There is a \$15 Non-Member Fee for all non-member riders.

Juniors (under 16) MUST be accompanied on trail by an adult (18+).

Directions

From High Prairie, AB, Take Hwy 749 north (MAC's intersection). Drive until you cross the South Heart River Bridge, slow down, and take your next left (west on TWP 755B – google has it wrong!). Follow this gravel road approximately 2 miles and you will see signs leading you to camp.

Camping

Camp open Friday AM. We will be in a grassy field. Water for horses will be available around camp and in crewing area. Lots of grass. No power so bring your generator. Porta-potties on site. Manure to be spread and all garbage taken away.

No frills ride – only meals for volunteers and vets will be provided.
